

## Prevention and Protection against COVID

Besides, the college is sanitized every day, COVID appropriate behavioral norms have been displayed in the campus, entry is not allowed in campus without face mask, temperature of each student, faculty and staff member as well as visitor is monitored at the main gate and at the same place their hands are sanitized, special Foot Operated Sanitizer Dispensers and hand-wash tanks have been installed in the campus, instead of a handshake for greeting the use of “Namaste” is promoted. All these efforts have been focused at prevention and protection against COVID-19.

### **Evidence of Success**

S.D. College, Hoshiarpur has seen a massive success in maximum events organized for prevention and protection against COVID-19. The students, faculty, and staff members are

successfully sensitized for personal and public care. No entry is allowed in the college campus without face mask; temperature is monitored and hands are sanitized at gate; COVID vaccination drives and awareness camps have been successfully organized. Besides, entire campus is sanitized everyday. The usage of special Foot Operated Sanitizer Dispensers and hand-wash tanks have helped reduce the risk of COVID-19.

### **Resources Required**

The journey of prevention and protection against COVID-19 has required various resources which include coordination with district health centers for vaccination drives, infrastructural facilities such as special Foot Operated Sanitizer Dispensers and hand-wash tanks, stitching of face masks, digital thermometers, electric spray pumps to sanitize the campus, publication of COVID awareness pamphlets and flex for various drives, wall paintings for COVID awareness messages, etc.

### **Challenges**

No activity of prevention and protection against COVID-19 has ever been without pitfalls. The major hurdle was to get maximum people jabbed against COVID-19 as most of them had been unwilling to get vaccinations. Besides, shortage of vaccines also created an obstacle. Then, asking people to wear face masks had been another challenge. Above all, online teaching and examinations during COVID period were the real acid tests of the faculty members and the students.
