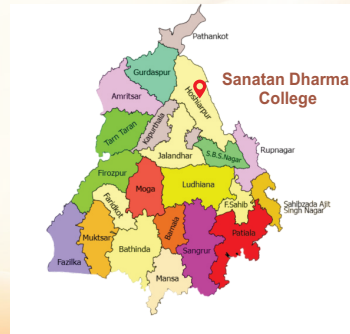
The college aims at spreading the light of knowledge for the development of a healthy society by offering empowerment through quality education coupled with social and moral awareness.

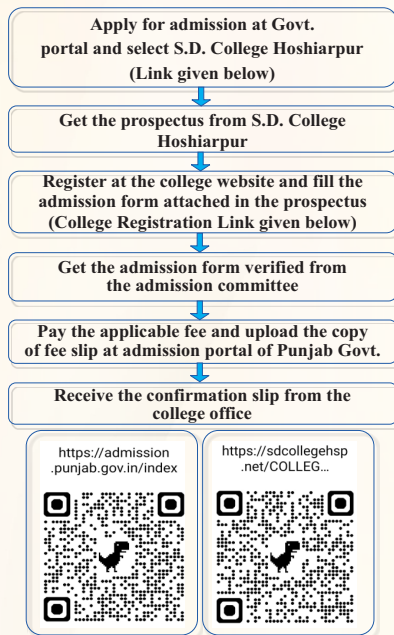

#### Continuing Students

Current students must present themselves for interviews with their respective admission committees, submitting complete application forms according to the published schedule. For semester progression (second to third or fourth to fifth semester), candidates must successfully complete 50% of total papers for that academic period. Fractional percentages (2.5, 3.5) will be rounded up to the next whole number (3, 4).

- Application submission does not guarantee admission

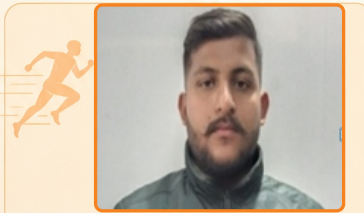

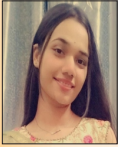

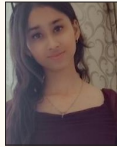
